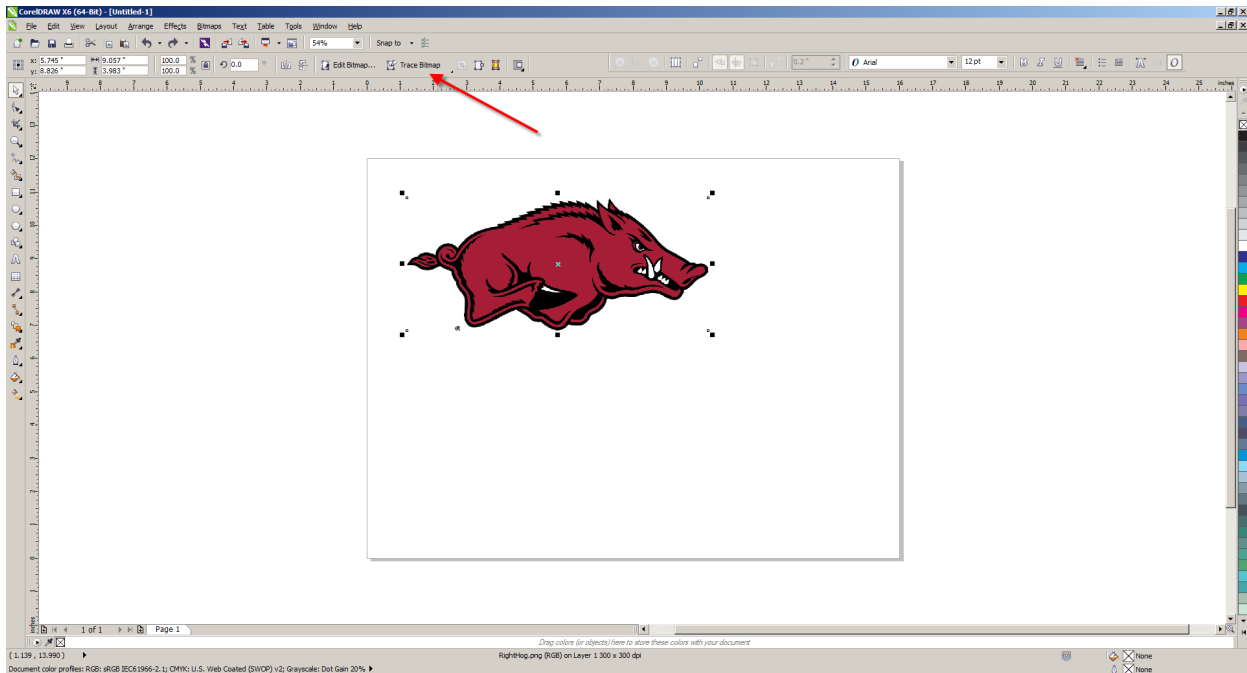


Converting an Image to Vector in CoreIDRAW

1. Import the Image in a New File by going to the **File Menu**, choose **Import, select Image** and click **Import button**.
2. Now place the image on the page by clicking.
3. In the Property bar click on **Trace Bitmap** and choose **Quick Trace** (or try one of many of the tracing options). The image has now been converted to Vector. At this point you can Ungroup the vectors and select **Create Boundary** to use the outline of a shape or image.



4. You can now save your file in CDR format to be edited later. You may also export an **EPS** format from CoreIDRAW by going to **File Menu** and choosing **Export** which open the Export Dialog. **Choose EPS** from the dropdown and hit the **Export button**.
